POOL REGULATIONS-REMEMBER THE FOLLOWING!



- Children under 13 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.

ANIMAL RULES FOR VALLEY VIEW



- ◆ Please walk your pets in the designated areas only! All waste must be picked up and disposed of. Failure to do so will result in a \$25,00 fine.
- ◆ The animal must not disturb the neighbors or other residents, regardless of whether the animal is inside or outside the dwelling.
- ◆ Your animal must be fed and watered inside your unit. Do not leave animal food or water outside at any time.
